EXPLANATION OF OUR CITY'S NAME

"Grove is very common in southern place names, and it usually indicates a spot where a camp meeting has taken place. I have always enjoyed driving through the piney woods of the South and coming across some little handmade sign pointing down a narrow, sandy road among the trees that says Shady Grove Methodist Church or Pleasant Grove Camp Meeting, and so on. I believe that the word is most often related to the Methodist church, whose camp meetings before the Civil War were the only ones open to blacks. In any case, we are reminded of its original meaning in such names as Pacific Grove, California; Webster Grove, Missouri; Hamilton Grove, Massachusetts; Ocean Grove, New Jersey; all of which were originally campmeeting places."
